#### SUMMER SCHOOL

Who is eligible?

Any student who fails a course during SY19-20 with a grade of 64 or lower. Students who failed a course with a 65-69 and who do not complete the Intercession assignments will also be eligible.

Where will summer school take place? All summer school courses will be virtual.

What is summer school? Summer school will begin on June 29, 2020 and end on July 31, 2020.

### HOW TO CREATE A POWERSCHOOL ACCOUNT



ENTER URL IN SEARCH ENGINE https://seedschool.powerschool.com/public/



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CLICK "CREATE AN ACCOUNT"

GUARDIAN'S NAME & EMAIL Enter your first & last names and email address in the designated fields.

CREATE A PASS WORD Enter a password of your choosing - at least 6 characters.



RE-ENTER PASS WORD Enter the password, again.



#### ENTER STUDENT'S NAME

Student's name must be entered exactly as it appears in PowerSchool. If you have multiple children @ SEED DC, each will have their own access ID & access password.



ENTER ACCESS CONFIDENTIAL ID This is provided by the school.



ENTER ACCESS PASSWORD This is provided by the school



RELATIONSHIP TO STUDENT

Select the option which indicates your relationship to the student.



#### ADDITIONAL CHILDREN?

Follow steps 6-9 if you have more than one scholar at the school.

Once these steps are completed, you will be taken to the Portal's login page and will sign-in with your newly created username and password











