DC Citywide Family Survey

The city is seeing strong rates of participation – more than 8,000 surveys complete so far – and is committed to reaching as many families as possible. Your feedback will provide our school and the city's leadership with valuable information to support a safe school reopening in the fall. *The survey will remain open until Monday, June 8th*. A few details:

- 1. The survey is anonymous, though you have the option to provide your contact information.
- 2. The survey was designed to get feedback on your family's needs in full. This means you only need to complete the survey once, even if you have multiple students at different schools.
- 3. You should enter demographic and school enrollment for all of your children.
- 4. There are open comment boxes for you to share more about different needs your children may have as you plan for next year's return.
- 5. The survey will be available until June 8, 2020 at 10:00 PM.


Where will summer school take place?

HOW TO CREATE A POWERSCHOOL ACCOUNT

- 1 ENTER URL IN SEARCH ENGINE
 https://seedschool.powerschool.com/public/
- 2 CLICK "CREATE AN ACCOUNT"
- GUARDIAN'S NAME & EMAIL

 Enter your first & last names and email address in the designated fields.
- 4 CREATE A PASS WORD
 Enter a password of your choosing at least 6 characters.
- 5 RE-ENTER PASSWORD
 Enter the password, again.
- 6 Student's name must be entered exactly as it appears in PowerSchool. If you have multiple children @ SEED DC, each will have their own access ID & access password.
- 7 ENTER ACCESS CONFIDENTIAL ID
 This is provided by the school
- 8 ENTER ACCESS PASSWORD
 This is provided by the school.
- 9 RELATIONSHIP TO STUDENT
 Select the option which indicates your relationship to the student.
- ADDITIONAL CHILDREN?

 Follow steps 6-9 if you have more than one scholar at the school.

The PowerSchool Parent Portal gives parents access to real-time information including attendance, grades and detailed assignment descriptions, and even personal messages from the teacher.




